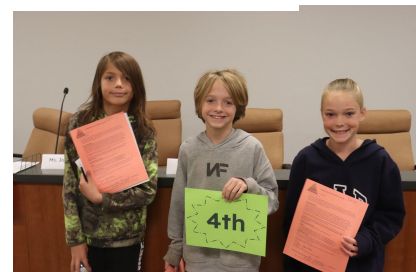
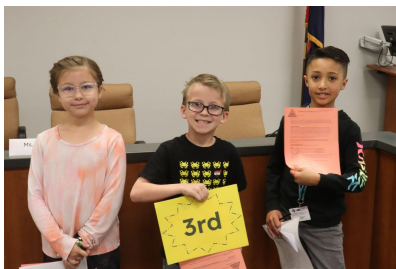

Through competitions at the school and then district level, three students are chosen from each grade level to form teams of six to put their math skills to the test and compete against teams from other West Valley school districts.
