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# LIBERTY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 25 ANNOUNCES WINNERS OF DISTRICT WESTSIDE IMPACT MATH CHALLENGE

**BUCKEYE** (March 24, 2023) – Liberty Elementary School District No.25 is pleased to announce its district winners for the Westside Impact Math Challenge. Students competed March 23 at the district level to qualify for the regional competition.

Through competitions at the school and then district level, three students are chosen from each grade level to form teams of six to put their math skills to the test and compete against teams from other West Valley school districts. Third and fourth grade are a team, fifth and sixth grade are paired together, and so are seventh and eighth grade.

The three teams will meet with their coaches for six practice sessions to build trust, camaraderie, and communication skills before traveling to the WestMEC campus on May 11 to compete against teams from other West Valley districts.
